Glossary

Kalo: corm or underground stem
Huli: part of the plant that is used for re-planting after the leaves and corm are removed
lau or lū 'au: leaf
kumu hā: stalk of leaf base
hā: leaf stalk
huluhulu: feeder roots
'ohā: bud of corm
'ōmu'ōmu'o: bud stalk
'ili kalo: skin of corm
iho kalo: core of corm
makamaka: bud of shoots
ao lū 'au or mohala: leaf blade rolled inside the stalk of last expanded leaf
pua: flower
piko: place where the stem is attached to the leaf
mahae: leaf indentation
ka'e lau: edge of leaf
ke alo o ka lau: upper surface of the leaf
